Appropriate Provincial Minister	In respect of a province, means the province's minister of the Crown who has primary responsibility for that province's finances
Authorities Policy	Policy that reflects authorities in connection with the management and investment of the assets of the CPP Investment Board, and in the approval of expenditures, which policy has been approved by the Board
bCPP	The base Canada Pension Plan, as defined in section 91 of the CPP Act
Board	The board of directors of the CPP Investment Board
Board Committee	A committee of the Board which is comprised of Directors and operates in accordance with a Board approved terms of reference and <b>Board Committee</b> <b>Guidelines</b>
Business Plan	Plan (including budget) prepared by Management for the fiscal year for review and approval by the Board
By-laws	By-laws of the CPP Investment Board
CFRO	The Senior Managing Director and Chief Financial and Risk Officer of the CPP Investment Board



Chairperson	The Chairperson of the Board
Code of Conduct	A document establishing a code of conduct for Directors, Officers and Employees and procedures for identifying potential conflicts of interest and resolving such conflicts of interest, which document is reviewed and approved by the Board from time to time
Committee Chair	The chairperson of a Board Committee
Conduct Review Advisor	A part-time external contact for and advisor to Directors, Officers and Employees, and relevant third parties, with respect to issues arising under the Code of Conduct on the basis contemplated therein
Corporate Secretary	The Senior Managing Director, General Counsel and Corporate Secretary of the CPP Investment Board

Governance Policy for CPPIB Group Companies	Policy relating to governance of CPPIB Group Companies, which policy is reviewed and approved by the Governance Committee
Governor in Council	The Governor General acting on the advice of the Committee of Council. Orders and Minutes of Council are signed by the Governor General and thus give legal force to Cabinet decisions taken pursuant to a statutory authority
Guidelines for Board Committees	Guidelines which provide elaboration upon each Board Committee's terms of reference
Guidelines for the Board	Guidelines which provide elaboration upon the Terms of Reference for the Board
